Brevard Autism Coalition creates opportunities for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder. For the past 14 years, the 5K has provided funding for local children to attend summer camps designed with their socio-emotional needs in mind. The Brevard Autism Coalition 5K for Autism awareness raised significant funds to support the Prevocational Camp this past March. Funds raised through the Run for the Kids Challenge provided 4 scholarships for adolescents attending the Prevocational Adventure Camp and 15 scholarships were given for children and adolescents to attend the Camp-2-Can camp in June. Brianna Marie Foundation, benefitted by the Brianna Marie Foundation 5K on March 2023

The Brianna Marie Foundation is a grassroots Brevard nonprofit that has raised more than \$710K in eleven years to fund research and support for fetal therapies, or surgeries that can be performed on babies while they are still in the womb. The Brianna Marie Foundation works with medical institutions around the world and conducts studies that are providing hope to babies and families that receive a negative fetal diagnosis. The BMF also serves as a resource for families that have lost a child and honors them each year at their event. The funds used from the 2023 event have been distributed to fund research on babies diagnosed with Spina Bifida and new methods to perform the surgery in leading edge ways that are safer than older traditional techniques. They have also worked closely with the University of California, San Francisco to fund a world-renowned Fetal Hydrops Center of Excellence where patients from around the world can reach out for medial and genetic guidance.
